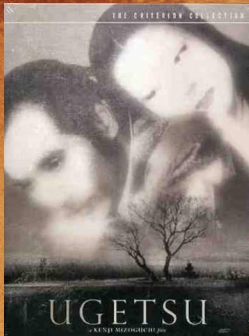


# MOVIE NIGHT
